

Transmutation Notes – 2016

Latin American Roaming Art Residency, Galápagos, Ecuador (March 2016) / Exhibition at Centro de Arte Contemporáneo, Quito (September 2016)

Cotton prints, ceramic bowls, glazed newspaper, linen, cotton, raw canvas, black felt, and grey stone cardboard box. Variable dimensions.

Transmutation Notes was created during a residency in the Galápagos, inspired by Darwin's notebooks and embodied awareness of place. The resulting works—bowls, gut-like forms, prints, and textiles—act as a sensitive skin for storing lived experience. Reassembled in Quito, the installation became a material poetics of observation, where the organic and the intimate take shape as a visual and tactile archive.
